Eat & Drink

Wiener Schnitzel



Made of a thin, breaded pan-fried veal cutlet

Tafelspitz



Boiled veal or beef in broth, served with a mix of vegetables and horseradish

Käsespätzle



Hot Spätzle pasta with grated cheese, such as cheddar cheese, Emmentaler or granular cheese, and decorated with fried onions

Hintere Schweinsstelze



It is a pork paw, typically stuffed with chestnuts, and dried plums before it is roasted

Schweinebraten



It is a typical Austrian roast pork served with potatoes or vegetables

Rinderroulade



It is a meat dish, usually consisting of bacon, onions, mustard and pickles wrapped in thinly sliced beef which is then cooked

Semmelknödel



Kind of bread dumplings made from dried wheat bread, milk, and eggs

Gulasch



Is a stew or soup of beef meat and vegetables usually seasoned with paprika and other spices

Frittatensuppe



Made as plain crepe-style pancakes then tightly rolled up and sliced into coils, and then usually served in a clear vegetable soup or beef broth

Kürbiscremesuppe



Pumpkin cream soup

Topfensuppe



Soup prepared with sour cream, cumin seeds and aromatic herbs, usually accompanied by croutons

Gefüllte Paprika



Peppers filled with pork or veal meat

Sacher Torte



Cake consists of a dense chocolate cake with a thin layer of apricot jam in between two halves, coated in dark chocolate icing on the top and sides. It is traditionally served with unsweetened whipped cream

Apfelstrudel



Consists of an oblong strudel pastry jacket with an apple filling inside. The filling is made of grated cooking apples (usually of a tart, crisp and aromatic variety)

Kaiserschmarrn



It is a lightly sweetened pancake, served as a dessert or as a light lunch, accompanied by jam

Krapfen



Holeless doughnut, filled with marmalade, chocolate or vanilla cream

Mozartkugeln



A small, round sugar confection made of pistachio, marzipan and nougat that is covered with dark chocolate. It was originally known as Mozart-Bonbon

Marillenknödel



Small sweet dumplings are formed from dough, in which cored apricots or mirabelle plums are placed. The dumplings are then boiled in slightly salted water and covered in crispily fried bread crumbs and powdered sugar

Wiener Melange



Part of the Coffee culture in Vienna, its taste is similar as an italian cappuccino

Almdudler



It is a sweetened sparkling beverage made of herbal extracts. Almdudler has been called the "national drink of Austria". Its popularity second only to Coca-Cola. About 80 million liters of the beverage are produced per year

Schlumberger



It is the most famous austrian sparkling wine. The company is located in the 19th district of Vienna, Heiligenstädter Strasse 43

Grüner Veltliner



It is a light white wine grape variety grown primarily in the Burgerland area in Austria

Zweigelt



It is the most widespread red wine variety in Austria, origin is located in Klosterneuburg.
It comprises a crossing between St. Laurent and Blaufränkisch

Ottakringer Beer



The most popular beer brand made in Ottakring Factory in Vienna

Street Food

Käsekrainer



It is a type of lightly smoked Brühwurst ("scalded sausage" or "parboiled sausage") that can be cooked, roasted or grilled, containing roughly torn bits of pork and 10% to 20% cheese. They are sold all over Austria at Würstelstand outlets.
The original Käsekrainer is served with mustard and freshly cut horseradish.

Leberkäse - Semmel



Leberkäse, in German literally 'liver-cheese'; It consists of beef, pork and bacon and is made by grinding the ingredients very finely and then baking it as a loaf in a bread pan until it has a crunchy brown crust. Most of the time, it is served hot on a Semmel (hard wheat flour bread-roll) and traditionally seasoned with mustard or pickles.

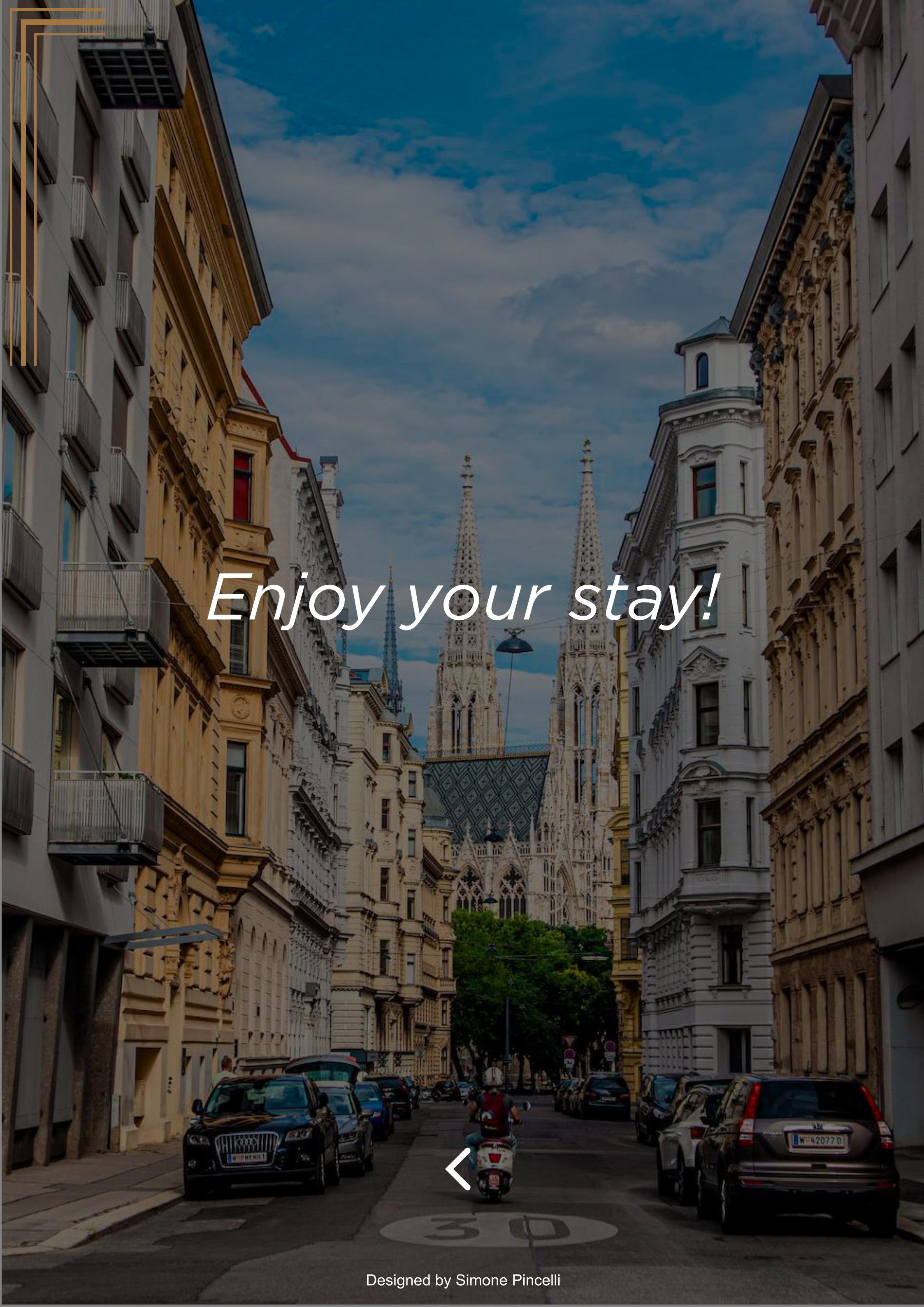
